

Based upon respondent's convictions in the 30<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court on July 27, 2015 and October 7, 2015, it was established that respondent was convicted of embezzlement by an agent or trustee (\$200 or more but less than \$1,000), in violation of MCL 750.174(3)(a), and a third offense of operating while intoxicated, in violation of MCL 257.625(6)(D). Therefore, the panel found that respondent engaged in conduct that violated the criminal laws of the State of Michigan, in violation of MCR 9.104(5).

The panel concluded that respondent knowingly failed to respond to lawful demands for information from a disciplinary authority, in violation of MRPC 8.1(a)(2); failed to answer two requests for investigation, in violation of MCR 9.104(7) and MCR 9.113(A) and (B)(2); in addition to violating MRPC 8.4(a); MCR 9.104(1); MCR 9.104(2); and MCR 9.104(3).

The panel ordered that respondent be disbarred from the practice law in Michigan. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,834.48.
