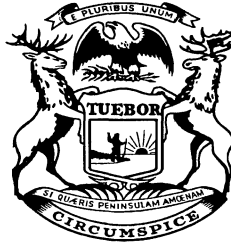


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**NOTICE OF REPRIMAND WITH CONDITIONS**



1. Reprimand
2. Effective July 12, 2016

The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The panel found that respondent's misdemeanor conviction for OWI/per se, 2nd offense, a misdemeanor, in violation of MCL 257.6256B, established that respondent engaged in conduct that violated the criminal laws of the State of Michigan, contrary to MCR 9.104(5).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent be reprimanded and subject to conditions relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$791.88.
