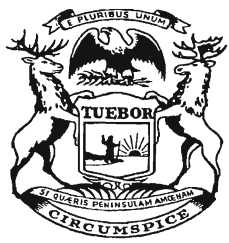


Nader W. Nassif, P 72557, Royal Oak, Michigan, by the Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #53.

1. Suspension - 180 Days
2. Effective January 6, 2015<sup>1</sup>

Respondent pleaded no contest, in the Washtenaw County Circuit Court, to the charge of Felonious Assault, a felony, in violation of MCL 750.82. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended May 23, 2014, the date of his conviction.

The Grievance Administrator filed a judgment of conviction on August 12, 2014, and, on October 31, 2014, the parties filed a Stipulation for Consent Order of Discipline in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5). The stipulation contained respondent's acknowledgment of his conviction. Based on respondent's conviction, the panel found that he violated the criminal laws of the State of Michigan, contrary to MCR 9.104(A)(5).

In accordance with the stipulation, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 180 days, effective January 6, 2015. The panel also ordered that respondent be subject to conditions relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$841.25.
