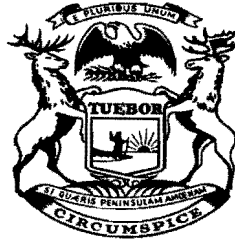


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NOTICE OF SUSPENSION WITH CONDITION

Case No. 14-45-GA

Notice Issued: November 21, 2014

Eric L. Naslund, P 42648, Sylvan Lake, Michigan, by the Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #62.

1. Suspension - 179 Days
2. Effective November 1, 2014

Respondent filed an answer to the complaint and appeared at the hearing. Based on the stipulation of the parties, the panel found that respondent held funds other than client or third person funds in an IOLTA account, in violation of MRPC 1.15(a)(3); failed to hold property of clients or third persons separate from his own, in violation of MRPC 1.15(d); and engaged in conduct in violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct, contrary to MRPC 8.4(a) and MCR 9.104(4). The panel acknowledged that the Grievance Administrator had no evidence that respondent improperly used, converted or misappropriated any client funds.

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law be suspended for 179 days, effective November 1, 2014, and that he be subject to a condition relevant to the alleged misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,028.08.
