The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The stipulation contained respondent's admission that he was convicted of operating while intoxicated, third, a felony, in violation of MCL 257.6256D. Based on respondent's conviction and his admission, the panel found that respondent engaged in conduct that violated the criminal laws of the State of Michigan, contrary to MCR 9.104(5).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 179 days, effective September 23, 2014, as stipulated by the parties. Additionally, the panel ordered that respondent be subject to conditions relevant to the admitted misconduct. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$756.69.
