The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The stipulation contained respondent's admission that he was convicted, by plea, for obstruction of justice, a felony, in violation of MCL 750.505; and for impaired driving, a misdemeanor, in violation of MCL 257.6251. Based on respondent's convictions and his admissions, the panel found that respondent engaged in conduct that violated the criminal laws of the State of Michigan, contrary to MCR 9.104(5).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for four years and eleven months, effective August 28, 2014, as stipulated by the parties. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$770.07.
