

2. Effective April 19, 2014

The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. Based on respondent's plea of no contest, the hearing panel found that respondent failed to explain a matter to the extent reasonably necessary to permit his clients to make informed decisions regarding the representation, in violation of MRPC 1.4(b); undertook the representation of clients that was or could have been materially limited by the lawyer's own interests, in violation of MRPC 1.7(b); and prepared an instrument giving the lawyer and a person related to the lawyer as spouse a substantial gift from a client, including a testamentary gift where the lawyer was not related to the donee, in violation of MRPC 1.8(c). The panel also found the respondent violated MRPC 8.4(a) and (b); and MCR 9.104(2)-(4).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 30 days. The panel also ordered that respondent be subject to a condition relevant to the alleged misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$812.41.
