The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. Based on respondent's admission, the panel found that respondent represented a client when the representation of that client was materially limited by respondent's responsibilities to another client, in violation of MRPC 1.7(b); represented a client when the representation of that client was materially limited by respondent's own interests, in violation of MRPC 1.7(b); failed to seek the lawful objectives of a client, in violation of MRPC 1.2(a); and failed to act with reasonable diligence on behalf of a client, in violation of MRPC 1.3. The panel also found that respondent violated MRPC 8.4(a) and MCR 9.104(3) and (4).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent be reprimanded and be subject to a condition relevant to the admitted misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$757.17.
