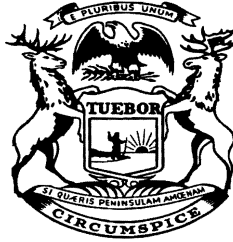

NOTICE OF SUSPENSION WITH CONDITION
(By Consent)

Case No. 12-34-GA

Notice Issued: June 25, 2013

Thomas E. Marshall, P 30633, Rochester, Michigan, by Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #56.

1. Suspension - 30 Days
2. Effective June 25, 2013

The hearing panel found that respondent failed to hold property of clients or third persons in connection with a representation separate from his own property, in violation of MRPC 1.15(d); deposited his own funds in a client trust account, in violation of MRPC 1.15(f); and engaged in conduct that is a violation of the Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct, contrary to MRPC 8.4(a) and MCR 9.104(4).

The respondent and the Grievance Administrator, through their respective counsel, filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 30 days and that he be subject to a condition relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,777.18.
