Reinstated, Effective July 9, 2021

Petitioner's license to practice law in Michigan was suspended on September 17, 2010, for two years and 11 months. On December 12, 2019, petitioner filed a petition for reinstatement pursuant to MCR 9.123 and MCR 9.124, which was assigned to Livingston County Hearing Panel #1. After a hearing on the petition, the panel concluded that petitioner satisfactorily established her eligibility for reinstatement and on February 24, 2021, issued an Order of Eligibility for Reinstatement With Conditions.
