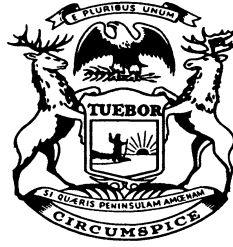


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NOTICE OF SUSPENSION
(By Consent)

1. Suspension - 3 Years
2. Effective June 22, 2011

The respondent and Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. Respondent pleaded no contest to the allegations that she practice law and held herself out as an attorney during a period of suspension and engaged in conduct that violates a criminal law of a state or of the United States, to wit: committing forgery, contrary to MCL §MCL 750.248

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(5); MCR 9.119(E)(1) and (3); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 8.4(a) and (b).

In accordance with the stipulation, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for three years. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$777.88.
