Respondent pleaded guilty to one count of felony tax evasion, in violation of 26 USC §7201, in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Michigan. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan is suspended effective May 10, 2011, the date of his felony conviction.

A discipline proceeding was instituted by the Grievance Administrator in accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(3). On December 27, 2011, the respondent and Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The panel found that, based on his felony conviction, respondent had committed professional misconduct in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(5).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the panel ordered that respondent be disbarred from the practice of law in Michigan, retroactive to May 10, 2011, the date of his felony conviction. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,238.13.
