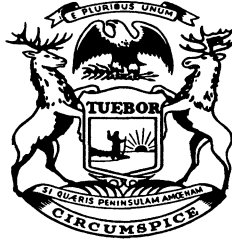


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NOTICE OF SUSPENSION WITH CONDITION

Notice Issued: May 2, 2011

Jose A. Sandoval, P 57274, Wyoming, Michigan, by Attorney Discipline Board Kent County Hearing Panel #2.

1. Suspension - 2 ½ Years
2. Effective April 15, 2011¹

Respondent was convicted by jury verdict in the U.S. District Court, Western District of Michigan, for obstruction the due administration of justice, a felony, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §1503. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan is suspended effective May 3, 2010, the date of his felony conviction.

Based on respondent's conviction and the testimony presented to the panel at the public hearings, the panel found that respondent had committed professional misconduct in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1), (3)-(5); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 3.3(a)(1); 4.3; and 8.4(a) - (c).

The panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for two and half years and that he be subject to a condition relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,238.92.
