The respondent and the Grievance Administrator submitted a stipulation for consent order of discipline in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5). The stipulation was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and was accepted by the hearing panel. The stipulation contains respondent's admission that he was convicted in the 6<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of OUIL/per se, third offense, a felony. The panel found that respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(5).

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 179 days, effective December 8, 2010. The panel further ordered that respondent be subject to conditions relevant to the admitted misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$876.88.
