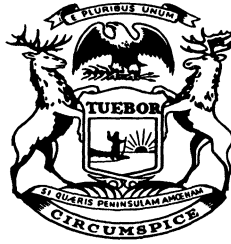


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**NOTICE OF REVOCATION AND RESTITUTION**  
**(By Consent)**

**Notice Issued: January 12, 2011**

William A. Garrett, P 13859, Sylvania, Ohio, by the Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #2.

1. Revocation
2. Effective May 19, 2010<sup>1</sup>

Respondent was convicted in the Lucas County Court of Common Pleas in Toledo, Ohio, of two counts of felony Grand Theft, in violation of R.C. 2913.02(A)(2) & (B)(2). In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan is suspended effective May 19, 2010, the date of his felony conviction.

The respondent and Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The panel found that, based on his felony convictions, respondent had committed professional misconduct in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(5).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be revoked, effective May 19, 2010, and that he pay restitution in the aggregate amount of \$16,767.00. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$755.54.
