The respondent did not appear at the hearing and was found to be in default for his failure to file an answer to the formal complaint. Based on that default, the panel found that respondent neglected three client matters; failed to act with reasonable diligence and promptness on behalf of his clients; failed to keep his client informed, and failed to comply promptly with his clients' requests for information; failed to promptly pay or deliver funds to which a client or third person was entitled; failed to hold the property of two clients separate from his own property; failed to refund unearned fees to two clients; knowingly failed to respond to a lawful demand for information by a disciplinary authority; and failed to answer three requests for investigation.

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(2)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113; MCR 9.115(D); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.3; 1.4(a); 1.15(b)(3); 1.15(d); 1.16(d); 8.1(a)(2); and 8.4(a) and (b).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be revoked and that he pay restitution in the aggregate amount of \$40,690.00. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,179.56.
