The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. Respondent admitted that he pled guilty to impaired driving, a misdemeanor, on August 22, 2006. Additionally, respondent admitted that he failed to provide notice of his conviction; and failed to timely answer a request for investigation.

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A) and (B)(2); MCR 9.120(A); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 8.1(a)(2); and 8.4(a) and (c).

The parties agreed that respondent should be suspended for 60 days and that he serve a two year probationary period with conditions relevant to the admitted misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,505.32.
