Respondent filed an answer to the formal complaint and appeared at the public hearing. Based on respondent's admissions, the hearing panel found that respondent neglected a legal matter entrusted to her; failed to seek her client's lawful objectives; failed to act with reasonable diligence and promptness in representing her client; failed to promptly render a full accounting of the monies paid to respondent upon request by the client or third person; failed to surrender papers and property to which the client is entitled and failed to refund the advance payment of monies; violated or attempted to violate the Rules of Professional Conduct; and failed to file an answer to the request for investigation served upon her by the Grievance Administrator.

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A) and (B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.15(b)(3); 1.16(d); 8.1(a)(2); and 8.4(a). The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 45 days and that she pay restitution in the amount of \$1,008.00. The panel also ordered that respondent be subject to a condition relevant to the established misconduct.

Respondent filed a petition for review and requested a stay of the discipline, which was granted. Upon review, the Attorney Discipline Board affirmed the hearing panel's Order of Suspension and Restitution With Condition. Respondent filed a motion for reconsideration, which was denied by the Attorney Discipline Board on November 13, 2008. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,901.87.
