The respondent filed an answer to the formal complaint and appeared at the hearing. The panel found that respondent knowingly disobeyed an obligation under the rules of a tribunal when he failed to provide an accounting in a probate matter and failed to return over \$38,000 to the probate estate. Respondent also failed to hold client property separate from his own property. The panel further found that respondent, in a bankruptcy matter, failed to provide competent representation to his client; neglected the legal matter entrusted to him; failed to seek the lawful objectives of his client; failed to act with reasonable diligence and promptness in representing his client; and failed to keep his client reasonably informed and failed to explain the matter to the adequately to his client.

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1; 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.4(a) and (b); 1.15(d); 3.4(c); and 8.4(a)-(c);

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be revoked and that he pay restitution in the amount of \$38,125.57. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,204.25.
