The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), containing respondent's plea of no contest to allegations of professional misconduct in the formal complaint. (See Notice of Suspension issued December 14, 2006).

The parties agreed that respondent should be suspended for 30 days. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$780.90. The hearing panel accepted the stipulation of the parties and issued and order on November 22, 2006 suspending respondent's license to practice law in Michigan for a period of 30 days commencing December 14, 2006. A notice of suspension was issued by the Attorney Discipline Board on December 14, 2006.

The parties stipulated that the commencement date of respondent's 30 day suspension should be amended to March 19, 2007.
