## NOTICE OF REVOCATION AND RESTITUTION

Based on respondent's default for his failure to file an answer to the formal complaint and his failure to appear at the hearing, the panel found that respondent, in a living trust matter, failed to advise his client that he had not prepared the living trust; failed to maintain reasonable communication with his client; failed to refund the unearned fees; and abandoned the representation of his client. Respondent was also found to have failed to answer a request for investigation served upon him by the Grievance Administrator.

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A) and (B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.4(a) and (b); 1.5(a); 1.16(d); 8.1(a)(2); and 8.4(a) and (c).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be revoked and that he pay restitution in the amount of \$1,500.00. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,708.04.
