The respondent did not appear at the hearing and was found to be in default for his failure to file an answer to the formal complaint. Based on that default, the panel found that respondent neglected a legal matter; failed to seek the lawful objectives of his client; failed to act with reasonable diligence and promptness; knowingly failed to respond to a lawful demand for information from a disciplinary authority; and failed to answer a request for investigation,

Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A) and (B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.4(a); 8.1(a)(2); and 8.4(a) and (c).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be revoked, retroactive to April 15, 2006, to run consecutive to the one-year suspension in *GA v Robert J. Connelly*, Case Nos. 04-41-GA; 04-165-GA. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,779.29.
