The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), containing respondent's plea of no contest to the allegations that he failed to act honestly in connection with escrow funds because he released \$5,000.00 to himself prior to fulfillment of the conditions precedent set by the funding agreement and escrow agreement executed by his client and another business in two separate matters; and failed to provide a full and fair answer to a request for investigation. Respondent was charged with violations of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.15(a) and (b); 8.1(b); and 8.4(a) and (b).

The parties agreed that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan should be suspended for three years and that he pay restitution in the aggregate amount of \$10,000.00. The parties also agreed that respondent shall be subject to conditions relevant to the alleged misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$995.07.
