The panel found that respondent, in a workers' compensation matter, failed to appear at a scheduled trial; and failed to answer a request for investigation served upon him by the Grievance Administrator. Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A); MCR 9.113(B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 8.1(a)(2) and 8.4(c).

The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline based on the panel's finding of misconduct. The parties agreed that respondent should be suspended for 30 days. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,608.17.

On September 28, 2005, respondent filed a petition for review regarding the amount of the costs imposed but withdrew the petition when the Grievance Administrator filed an objection.
