Based on respondent's conviction of theft of government property, a misdemeanor, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §641, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Michigan, the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 179 days with a condition relevant to the established misconduct.

Respondent filed a timely petition for review along with a request for a stay of discipline which was granted by the Attorney Discipline Board. The Grievance Administrator filed a cross-petition for review and the matter was scheduled for a review hearing. On July 25, 2005, the Attorney Discipline Board issued its order affirming the Tri-County Hearing Panel #71's order of suspension with condition. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,894.12.
