The hearing panel found that respondent knowingly neglected a legal matter entrusted to him; failed to act with reasonable diligence and promptness in representing his client; and failed to respond to the Grievance Administrator's lawful demand for information.

Respondent's misconduct was in violation of Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(3); 1.3; and 8.1(a)(2). The panel ordered that respondent be suspended for 120 days, effective August 25, 2005, to run concurrently with a suspension ordered in <u>Grievance Administrator v Harry R.</u> <u>Boffman, III</u>, Case No. 05-68-GA. The panel also ordered that respondent be subject to conditions relevant to the established misconduct. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,788.12.
