The respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a stipulation for a consent order of discipline, in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5), containing respondent's plea of no contest to the allegations that he misrepresented to his client that he had filed a complaint on his behalf; misrepresented to his client that a court date had been scheduled; and failed to institute suit on his client's behalf or advise him that he would not do so.

Respondent was charged with violations of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3; 1.4; 1.16; and 8.4(a)-(c). The parties agreed that respondent's license to practice law in Michigan should be suspended for 30 days beginning July 1, 2003, and that respondent should attend the State Bar of Michigan's Ethics School. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$760.22.
