

## **NOTICE OF REVOCATION AND RESTITUTION**

**Notice Issued: July 25, 2003**

Dennis P. O'Neill, P 42299, Livonia, Michigan by the Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #32.

1. Revocation.
2. Effective June 26, 2003<sup>1</sup>

The hearing panel found, based on respondent's admission, that respondent, while suspended from the practice of law, provided legal advice, appeared in court on behalf of a client, and accepted legal fees. Further, respondent never disclosed to his client, opposing counsel, or the court that he was a suspended lawyer. Respondent's conduct was found to be in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (9), MCR 9.119(E) and (F); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.5; 1.15(a)-(c); 3.3(a); and 8.4(a)-(c). The panel ordered that respondent's license be revoked and that he pay restitution in the amount of 1,000.00. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,742.68.

The Grievance Administrator filed a motion for reconsideration to amend the effective date of the order of revocation. The Attorney Discipline Board granted the motion and amended the effective date of respondent's revocation to June 26, 2003.
