- 1. Suspension 180 Days;
- 2. Effective February 16, 2002.

The hearing panel found by default that respondent, in a personal injury matter, failed to file a complaint on his client's behalf; failed to maintain reasonable communications with his client; abandoned his client's representation without taking reasonable steps to protect his client's legal interest; and failed to file an answer to a request for investigation served by the Grievance Administrator. Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A); MCR 9.113(B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.4(a) and (b); 1.16(d); 3.2; 8.1(b); and 8.4(a) and (c).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law be suspended for 180 days, to run concurrently with the suspension now in effect in <u>Grievance</u> <u>Administrator v Daniel F. Biernat</u>, Case No. 01-81-GA. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$245.24.
