- 1. Suspension 120 days.
- 2. Effective November 1, 2000.

The respondent and the Grievance Administrator submitted a stipulation for consent order of discipline in accordance with MCR 9.115(F)(5). The stipulation was approved by the Attorney Grievance Commission and was accepted by the hearing panel. Respondent entered a plea of no contest to the allegations contained in Counts One, Three and Four of Formal Complaint 00-28-GA, to wit: In a probate matter, respondent failed to file a closing inventory; failed to take any action to complete the estate; failed to respond to his client's inquiries regarding the status of the matter; made statements known by him to be false when responding to the request for investigation served by the Grievance Administrator; and failed to timely respond to letters from the Attorney Grievance Commission during the course of their investigation. Respondent's conduct was alleged to be in violation of MCR 9.103(C); MCR 9.104(1)-(4) and (6); MCR 9.113(A); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1(c); 1.2(a); 1.3; 1.4(a); 8.1(a) and (b); and 8.4(a)-(c). The parties agreed that Count Two of Formal Complaint 00-28-GA and Formal Complaint 00-57-FA should be dismissed and an order of suspension should be entered.

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license be suspended for 120 days. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$251.79.
