The Grievance Administrator filed Formal Complaint 99-105-GA on July 22, 1999, charging that respondent had committed acts of professional misconduct, specifically: That respondent, while still married, made two false statements that she had entered into a divorce agreement with her husband and did not correct or rectify the record when her husband was described as her "exhusband." Respondent was alleged to be in violation of MCR 9.104(1)-(4); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 3.3(a)(1) and (4); 3.3(b); and 8.4(a)-(c).

The hearing panel conducted a hearing on September 14, 1999 and filed a report concluding that professional misconduct had not been established. The panel entered an order dismissing Formal Complaint 99-105-GA. No costs were assessed against respondent. On February 8, 2000, the Grievance Administrator filed a Conditional Petition for Review. On July 12, 2000, the Attorney Discipline Board entered an order and opinion affirming the dismissal.
