On April 14, 2000, respondent entered a plea of guilty in the Oakland County Circuit Court to the felony of OUIL - third offense, MCR 257.6256(D). In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended April 14, 2000, the date of the conviction.

On September 28, 2000, the Grievance Administrator filed a judgment of conviction pursuant to MCR 9.120(B)(3). In accordance with that rule, the Attorney Discipline Board ordered respondent to appear before Tri-County Hearing Panel #104 to show cause why a final order of discipline should not be entered. A public hearing was held on November 20, 2000 and the hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law be suspended for 180 days, retroactive to April 14, 2000, the date of his felony conviction. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$136.99.
