Respondent admitted the following allegations of professional misconduct contained in Formal Complaint 99-74-GA, specifically: With respect to an estate matter, respondent failed to advise his client that she had no authority to give him permission to operate a vehicle belonging to the decedent; failed to disclose to the court, the special fiduciary and/or the opposing party, that he was operating the vehicle for his personal transportation and failed to obtain proper authority to do so; and failed to return the vehicle to the estate in substantially the same condition in which he received it. The panel found that respondent's conduct was found to be in violation of MCR 9.104(1)-(4); and the Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1; 1.2; 1.4(b); 1.15(a)-(c); and 8.4(a)-(c).

The panel ordered that respondent's license be suspended for two years commencing December 8, 1999, to run concurrently with a previous 18 month suspension effective January 8, 1999. (Grievance Administrator v Jonathan E. Holt, Case No. 97-235-GA). Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,614.75.

Respondent has been continuously suspended since January 8, 1999. See <u>Grievance Administrator v Holt</u>, ADB Case No. 97-235-GA.
