On April 29, 1999, respondent was convicted following a trial in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan of conspiring to launder money in violation of 18 USC §1956, a felony. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended on the date of that felony conviction. See <u>Notice of Automatic Interim Suspension</u> dated October 22, 1999.

The Grievance Administrator filed a certified copy of the Judgment of Conviction on January 11, 2000. The matter was assigned to a hearing panel and respondent was ordered to show cause why a final order of discipline should not be entered. On May 1, 2000, the hearing panel ordered the revocation of respondent's license to practice law in the State of Michigan effective April 29, 1999, the date fo the felony conviction. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$151.19.
