On February 4, 2000, respondent was convicted in Washtenaw County 14B District Court on two counts of Animals - Abandoning/Cruelty, misdemeanors, in violation of MCL 750.50. On March 12, 2002, the Grievance Administrator filed a certified copy of the Judgment of Conviction and a formal complaint alleging that respondent failed to file an answer to a Request for Investigation served by the Grievance Administrator. Based upon respondent's conviction and default, the hearing panel found that respondent had committed the alleged misconduct, in violation of MCL 750.50; MCR 9.104(A)(1)-(4) and (7); MCR 9.113(A); MCR 9.113(B)(2); and Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct 8.1(b); and 8.4(a) and (c).

The hearing panel ordered that respondent's license to practice law be suspended for 120 days, to run concurrently with the three year suspension ordered in <u>Grievance</u> <u>Administrator v Roy A. Ashmall</u>, Case No. 98-51-GA. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$191.93.
