NOTICE OF REPRIMAND

Kenneth S. Sebree, P 65523, Detroit, Michigan, by the Attorney Discipline Board Tri-County Hearing Panel #28.

Reprimand, Effective July 9, 2019.

After proceedings in accordance with MCR 9.115, the hearing panel found that respondent committed professional misconduct in his representation of a client and his mother in a negligence action involving an automobile accident. The panel ordered that respondent be reprimanded. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,816.50.
