On December 17, 1996, respondent was convicted in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan, by jury verdict, of one count of Money Laundering Conspiracy in violation of 18 USC 1956(a)(1)(A) and 1956(g). In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent was automatically suspended from the practice of law in Michigan effective December 17, 1996, the date of the felony conviction.

The parties thereafter stipulated that respondent's license to practice law be revoked effective December 17, 1996, the effective date of the automatic interim suspension. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$447.00.
