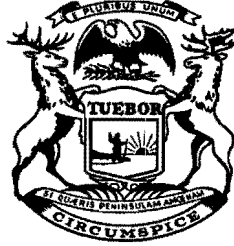


**Notice Issued: April 26, 2019**

Effective April 15, 2019.

On April 15, 2019, respondent was convicted of one count of attempted use of a computer to commit a crime (2-4 year offense), in violation of MCL 752.7973C(A), a felony under MCL 761.1(f), in a matter titled *People of the State of Michigan v Richard James Indermuehle*, 17<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court Case No. 19-00529-FH. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended on the date of his felony conviction.

Upon the filing of a certified judgment of conviction, this matter will be assigned to a hearing panel for further proceedings. The interim suspension will remain in effect until the effective date of an order filed by a hearing panel.
