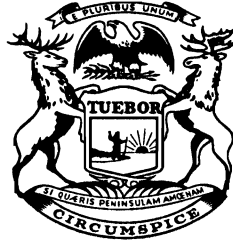


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NOTICE OF REPRIMAND

Phillip A. Stillman, P 75996, Jupiter, Florida, by the Attorney Discipline Board.

Reprimand, Effective October 13, 2018.

In a reciprocal discipline proceeding under MCR 9.120(C), the Grievance Administrator filed a certified copy of an Order of the Supreme Court of Florida, entered on January 16, 2016, reprimanding respondent Philip A. Stillman, *The Florida Bar v Philip Alain Stillman*, Supreme Court of Florida, Case No. SC16-905.

An order regarding imposition of reciprocal discipline was served upon respondent on July 18, 2018. The 21-day period referenced in MCR 9.120(C)(2)(b) expired without objection by either party and respondent was deemed to be in default. Based on that default, the Attorney Discipline Board ordered that respondent be reprimanded. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,513.67.
