## NOTICE OF REVOCATION

- 1) Revocation;
- 2) Effective August 13, 1987

The Respondent failed to answer the nine count Complaint filed April 20, 1987 and failed to appear at the hearing. The Hearing Panel concluded that Respondent's default constituted an admission of the charges of misconduct, to wit: that in his handling of the administration of a decedent's estate he failed to file annual accountings or turn over the assets of the estate to the successor fiduciary following his suspension as personal representative; that he subsequently filed a First and Final Account in that estate which falsely represented that certain disbursements had been made; that in his handling of a second decedent's estate, documents, distributed funds file necessary estate approximately \$14,000 without the authorization of the Probate Court and misappropriated to his own use the sum of \$17,233.34; that he neglected a divorce matter entrusted to him by a client; and that he failed to answer a Request for Investigation. Respondent's conduct was in violation of MCR 9.104(1-4, 7); MCR 9.113(A),(B)(2) and Canons 1, 6, 7 & 9 of the Code of DR 1-102(A)(1-6); DR 6-101(A)(3); Professional Responsiblity. 7-101(A)(1-3) and DR 9-102(B)(1,3,4); DR 9-102(D)(1-4). Costs were assessed in the amount of \$ 99.07

The Panel concluded that revocation of Respondent's license was warranted in light of the nature of the misconduct admitted by default, Respondent's failure to answer or appear in these proceedings, and a prior suspension of 150 days.

NOTE: Respondent's license was suspended for 150 days effective March 25, 1987 and until the effective date of this Order of Revocation.
