
NOTICE OF REVOCATION

File No. DP 18/86

Edwin G. Fabre, P 13265, 531 Ford Building, Detroit, MI 48226 by Attorney Discipline Board Wayne County Hearing Panel #17.

- 1) Revocation;
- 2) Effective April 3, 1987.

The Respondent failed to answer two Complaints filed by the Administrator and failed to appear at the hearing. The Panel found that misconduct had been established as alleged in the Complaints, to wit, that Respondent was retained in 1982 to represent a client in a claim against an insurance company but failed to take action after an order was entered quashing service upon the Defendant and failed to inform his client of the dismissal; that he failed to answer the Request for Investigation filed by that client in December, 1985; that in connection with his representation of the officers of a labor union, he took possession of union funds in the amount of \$1790.00 in May, 1984 and converted those funds to his own use; that he failed to answer the Request for Investigation filed in November 1985 regarding his representation in the union matter; that he failed to answer a further Request for Investigation filed in April, 1986 regarding an unrelated matter; and that he failed to answer the Formal Complaint served by the Grievance Administrator in December 1986. Respondent's conduct was found to be in violation of MCR 9.104(1-4;7); MCR 9.113; MCR 9.115(D). The Panel considered Respondent's failure to present any mitigating factors together with the aggravating effect of Respondent's three year suspension, effective October 21, 1986 for misconduct involving the misuse of client funds and determined that revocation was warranted. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$150.95.
