NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

File No. DP 90/84

ALFRED G. KAUFMAN, JR., P 27926, P.O. Box 156, Lusk, Wyoming 82225, by Order of the Wayne County Hearing Panel #22 of the Attorney Discipline Board.

- 1. Suspension
- 2. For a period of ninety (90) days.
- 3. Effective 23 July 1985.

Respondent admitted that the Supreme Court of Wyoming in March 1984 publicly reprimanded and censured him, and suspended his license to practice law in that state for one year. He was found in Wyoming to have habitually violated the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and U.S. District Court discovery orders; of misrepresentations to clients; of neglecting a case, and attempting legal services without adequate preparation; and of fradulently receiving funds from an estate without court approval.

The panel found that Respondent had violated former GCR 1963, 953 [now MCR 9.104], and Canons 1, 6, and 7 of the Code of Professional Responsibility: DR 1-102(A)(1)(2)(4)-(6); DR 6-101(A)(2)(3); DR 7-101(A)(3) and DR 7-106(C)(7). In assessing discipline, the panel noted that there will be no client notification requirements in Michigan since Respondent does not maintain an office here. Prior discipline of a reprimand in 1982 was considered. Costs of \$240.92 were imposed.
