
NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF LICENSE

File No. 37-84

THOMAS E. ANDERSON, (P26042), 4548 Westbrook Drive, Jackson, MI 49201, by Attorney Discipline Board Oakland County Hearing Panel #1.

- (1) Revocation of license
- (2) Effective September 26, 1984

Respondent was convicted of the felony of embezzlement over \$100 in the Jackson County Circuit Court pursuant to a plea of nolo contendere to said charge. He was sentenced to serve a term of five to ten years imprisonment and was remanded to the custody of the Michigan Department of Corrections. The criminal charge was based upon Respondent's misappropriation of sums of \$34,000 or more from the Jackson County TIP organization, a program created to encourage citizens to provide information to law enforcement agencies. The hearing panel found that Respondent occupied a fiduciary position of trust as the treasurer of the TIP program, and violated that duty. Respondent's license to practice was automatically suspended upon the conviction, by operation of GCR 1963, 969.1; Respondent failed to respond to the Attorney Discipline Board Order to Show Cause why a final order of discipline should not be entered. The panel found that Respondent did in fact have personal knowledge and notice of said Order to Show Cause and of the panel proceedings and that Respondent did not file a notice of objections or mitigation and did not make any other response to said Order to Show Cause. The panel found violations of GCR 1963, 953(1-5).
