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## NOTICE OF REVOCATION

File No. DP 135/84

Ernest L. Citron, P 11906, 20365 Briarwood, Southfield, MI 48076 by the Attorney Discipline Board increasing discipline to a Revocation.

- (1) Revocation;
- (2) Effective July 18, 1984. (An Interim Notice of Suspension was mailed July 24, 1984.)

Respondent's license to practice law was automatically suspended July 18, 1984 upon his conviction of the felonies of forgery and conspiracy to commit forgery. Pursuant to the Court rule, the Respondent was ordered to show cause why a final order of discipline should not be entered. Upon its review of a hearing panel order suspending the Respondent's license for a period of three years, the Attorney Discipline Board concluded that the gravity of Respondent's criminal conduct coupled with his past disciplinary history warranted revocation of his license to practice law. The Board noted that the Respondent had been suspended on two prior occasions and that one of those suspensions resulted from his conviction of federal income tax evasion.

Respondent's application for leave to appeal was denied by the Michigan Supreme Court in an Order dated April 29, 1986. Revocation is effective from the date of Respondent's automatic suspension, July 18, 1984. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$334.95.
