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AMENDED NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF LICENSE
(Correction of Effective Date)

File No. DP 72/83

Irving A. August, (P 10296), 555 S. Woodward Avenue, Birmingham, MI 48011, by the Michigan Supreme Court denying Application for Leave to Appeal the Decision of the Attorney Discipline Board.

- (1) Revocation of license;
- (2) Effective June 28, 1983.

The Respondent was found guilty by jury verdict in the United States District Court in the Eastern District of Michigan of three (3) counts of an indictment charging conspiracy to defraud the United States in violation of Title 18, U.S.C., Section 371 and two (2) counts of obstruction of justice in violation of Title 18, U.S.C., Section 1503. Count I charges that respondent conspired with an intake clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court, Eastern District of Michigan, to defraud the United States of the due administration of justice by manipulating the blind draw system with respect to Chapter 11 petitions filed by him and members of his law firm for the purpose of avoiding or minimizing the assignment of such petitions to a certain judge; the same facts were the basis for conviction under a separate count charging obstruction of justice.

The respondent was charged with another count of obstruction of justice, and was convicted pursuant thereto for knowingly, willfully and corruptly endeavoring to influence an officer of the United States Bankruptcy Court, an intake clerk, who had a duty to assign judges to cases according to the blind draw system.
