Suspension - 30 Days, Effective December 2, 2023

Respondent and the Grievance Administrator filed a Stipulation for Consent Order of

Discipline, pursuant to MCR 9.115(F)(5), which was approved by the Attorney Grievance

Commission and accepted by the hearing panel. The stipulation contained respondent's

admissions to the factual allegations - that he filed a frivolous lawsuit in Colorado federal court

against Dominion Voting Systems, Facebook, Mark Zuckerberg and others - and allegations of

professional misconduct set forth in paragraphs 34 (a) and (c) of the formal complaint filed by

the Grievance Administrator.

Based on respondent's admissions and the stipulation of the parties, the panel found that

respondent brought or defended a proceeding, or asserted or controverted an issue therein,

where the basis for doing so was frivolous, in violation of MRPC 3.1; and engaged in conduct

that exposes the legal profession or the courts to obloquy, contempt, censure, or reproach, in

violation of MCR 9.104(2).

In accordance with the stipulation of the parties, the hearing panel ordered that

respondent's license to practice law in Michigan be suspended for 30 days. The panel further

found that good cause existed for the order to take effect on December 2, 2023, as agreed to by

the parties. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$777.85.
