Respondent was convicted of Conspiracy to Commit Securities Fraud, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371, in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California. In accordance with MCR 9.120(B)(1), respondent's license to practice law in Michigan was automatically suspended effective October 25, 2016, the date of respondent's felony conviction. Based on respondent's conviction, the panel found that he committed professional misconduct that violated a criminal law of a state or of the United States, contrary to MCR 9.104(5).

The panel ordered that respondent be disbarred from the practice of law in Michigan. Total costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,894.26.
