Respondent was convicted by a jury of embezzlement, forgery, uttering and publishing. Respondent was further convicted, after pleading no contest, of two counts of misdemeanor larceny, and pleading guilty to two counts of drunk driving. Based on these convictions and respondent's agreement on the record at the hearing, the panel found that respondent engaged in conduct that violated a criminal law of a state, in violation of MCR 9.104(5); and engaged in conduct that violated criminal laws, where such conduct reflects adversely on the lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer, in violation of MRPC 8.4(b).

The panel ordered that respondent be disbarred from the practice law in Michigan. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,391.21.
