NOTICE OF DISBARMENT

Notice Issued: October 11, 2016

Charles D. Septowski, P 34065, St. Louis, Missouri, by the Attorney Discipline Board.

1. Disbarment
2. Effective October 8, 2016

In a reciprocal discipline proceeding under MCR 9.120(C), the Grievance Administrator filed a certified copy of a Judgement of Disbarment entered by District 9 Grievance Committee Evidentiary Panel 9-3 of the State Bar of Texas on March 3, 2015, effective retroactively to February 27, 2015, *Commission for Lawyer Discipline v Charles D. Septowski*, Case No. 201400356.

An order regarding imposition of reciprocal discipline was served upon respondent on June 17, 2016. The 21-day period referenced in MCR 9.120(C)(2)(b) expired without objection by either party and the respondent was deemed to be in default.¹ Based on that default, the Attorney Discipline Board ordered that respondent be disbarred from the practice of law in Michigan. Costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,500.00.
