ORDER INCREASING TWO YEAR SUSPENSION TO DISBARMENT

The Grievance Administrator petitioned the Attorney Discipline Board for review of the order of Muskegon County Hearing Panel #1, dated December 12, 2013, suspending the license to practice law of respondent, Shawn P. Davis, for a period of two years. The Attorney Discipline Board has conducted review proceedings in accordance with MCR 9.118, including review of the record before the hearing panel and consideration of the arguments and briefs presented by the parties. For the reasons discussed in the attached opinion, discipline is increased to disbarment.

NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED that respondent, Shawn P. Davis, is DISBARRED from the practice law in Michigan EFFECTIVE JANUARY 3, 2014, and until further order of the Supreme Court, the Attorney Discipline Board or a hearing panel, and until respondent complies with the requirements of MCR 9.123(B) and (C) and MCR 9.124.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the respondent shall comply with all applicable provisions of MCR 9.119.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent shall pay court reporting costs incurred by the Board for the review hearing conducted on March 19, 2014, in the amount of \$111.33. Costs shall be paid on or before November 5, 2014. Costs may be paid by check or money order made payable to the Attorney Discipline System and submitted to the Attorney Discipline Board, 211 West Fort St., Ste. 1410, Detroit, MI 48226, for proper crediting.
